

Shelter Rules and Floor Layout

Pointers for Applicants to Note:

- Shelter stay is temporary and for up to six months only in the first instance, and the Resident will <u>actively work towards developing self-reliance and overcoming</u> housing barriers.
- Residents who leave the shelter without informing the Shelter Staff for more than 48 hours are deemed to have absconded and will not be allowed to continue staying in the shelter unless the reasons for their absence are legitimate. Their belongings will be kept for 7 days and if left unclaimed, they will be donated to charity or discarded.
- The resident shall pay to AMKFSC Community Services (AMKFSC) a monthly shelter fee of Fifty Singapore Dollars only (SGD \$50). The shelter fee shall be paid to AMKFSC regularly on the 1st of every month. In the event of shelter fee being owed for 2 months or more, cases will be reviewed by the case worker and TPJBM reserves the rights to evict the resident. The resident is required to obtain an official receipt from AMKFSC Community Services Ltd. (AMKFSC) for any payment made to TPJBM.
- Residents are <u>not allowed to ask for monetary assistance or gifts from the staff,</u> <u>volunteers, or fellow residents</u>. This may include persons associated directly or indirectly with the shelter.
- To adhere to the <u>case plan as agreed with the social worker(s) through sessions twice a month</u>, including working with other relevant agencies such as Housing Development Board (HDB). <u>Jobless residents must actively seek employment</u> through their own effort or job matching service provided by external agencies. The Shelter Staff will monitor the progress of this effort. This will also form part of the review process to extend the stay for the resident.
- No unauthorised visitors or outsiders are allowed in the shelter unit.


Corridor
